Giving Schools the Option to Arm Certain School Personnel

This legislation would give schools the option to allow certain school personnel to have access to firearms in school buildings.

The board of school directors in a school district may establish a policy permitting school personnel access to firearms in the buildings or on the grounds of a school by:

- (1) Establishing a firearm safety plan;
- (2) Providing notification of the policy to parents and guardians of all students, and;
- (3) Providing notification to the nearest hospital where school personnel have access to firearms.

All School personnel permitted access to firearms in the school buildings or grounds must:

- (1) Have a license to carry a concealed firearm;
- (2) Maintain a current and valid certification in the use and handling of a firearm, and;
- (3) Complete a psychological evaluation.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.
