## THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF PENNSYLVANIA SESSION OF 2020

BILL NO.	TITLE of BILL	ACTION
<b>SENATE 1 VOTER ID</b> (State Government Committee) This legislation requires that all individuals that present themselves to vote at a Pennsylvania polling place must provide valid identification in order to cast a ballot.		
<b>SENATE 2 DRUG TESTING FOR WELFARE BENEFITS</b> (State Government Committee) This bill shall develop and implement a drug test and drug retest program for applicants and recipients of public assistance benefits through the Department of Human Services.		
<b>SENATE 3 ELIMINATION OF SCHOOL PROPERTY TAXES</b> (Finance Committee) This bill will eliminate the existing School Property Taxes for homeowners.		
<b>SENATE 4 DIGITAL PRODUCT SALES TAX INCREASE</b> (Finance Committee) This bill will have a sales tax of 8% added to the sale of any digital product transferred electronically.		
<b>SENATE 5 SCHOOL DISCIPLINE OF STUDENTS BULLYING OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL</b> (Education Committee) This legislation would provide penalties for students who engage in bullying activities outside of school property.		
<b>SENATE 6 OPTIONAL ARMING OF SCHOOL PERSONNEL</b> (Education Committee) .Current Pennsylvania law states that a weapon (the definition of which includes terms such as “firearm”, “shotgun” or “rifle”) at school can be “possessed and used in combination with a lawful supervised school activity or is possessed for other lawful purpose.”		
<b>SENATE 7 RIGHTS TO SOCIAL MEDIA UPON DEATH</b> (Judiciary Committee) This bill will give people the power to plan for the management and disposition of their digital assets in the same way they can make plans for their tangible property: by providing instructions in a will, trust, or power of attorney.		
<b>SENATE 8 ELIMINATION OF THE DEATH PENALTY</b> (Judiciary Committee) This legislation would provide that the death penalty be eliminated throughout the Commonwealth.		
<b>SENATE 9 CELL PHONE USE WHILE OPERATING A MOTOR VEHICLE</b> (Transportation Committee) This bill states the use of a hand-held cellular phone while operating a motor vehicle that is in motion upon a public roadway is prohibited.		
<b>SENATE 10 SEAT BELTS ON SCHOOL BUSES AND SCHOOL VEHICLES</b> (Transportation Committee) This bill will require that all school buses and school vehicles must be equipped with seat belts.
