Voter Identification

All individuals that present themselves to vote at a Pennsylvania polling place must provide valid identification in order to cast a ballot. Identification must be provided at every election.

Valid forms of identification include:

- Pennsylvania driver's license or PennDOT ID card
- ID issued by the U.S. Government
- U.S. passport
- U.S. Armed Forces ID
- Non-photo ID issued by the Commonwealth

Individuals without valid identification are permitted to cast provisional ballots, but must provide valid identification within five days of voting for the ballot to count.
